Future skills for a better life in Sustainable Salons

The project Future skills for a better life in Sustainable Salons (Sustainable Salon) had its Train the Trainer meeting in Malaga, Spain. In this Erasmus+ project, we have gathered facts through an inventory of the hairdresser's future competences in the situation in a sustainable salon and focus on environmental aspects (core of a simple standard). In the training course on 13th- 15th of February 2023, we introduced the Learning material to the participating teachers. The developed learning material was tested and evaluated during the training. The partners in the project also discussed the developed learning material for students, the teachers manuals and the teachers toolkit. In the coming period the developed material will be tested in the 4 participating schools. It will be finalized and translated in Dutch/Flemish, English, Italian and Spanish. The final versions will be published on the project-website: www.sustainable-salon.info. The other outputs are already published. During the meeting, we also worked on the awareness material on sustainability. Stickers are designed by students of the participating schools. A magazine to create awareness will be developed in the coming period.
