

## Homework assignment guest teachers Train the Trainer meeting Malaga 13-14-15 February 2023

Dear guest teacher!

We are very happy that you are going to join our enthusiastic Sustainable Salon team for the Train the Trainer meeting in Malaga! A very warm welcome!

We will need your help in testing the learning materials we have produced for this project and this is how exactly you can help. We would like you to prepare a few things before the Malaga meeting. In this document you will read what exactly we expect from you.

The learning materials consist of 3 different modules and 3 manuals. The first manual is for Students (Students' Manual or Text Book), the second for teachers (Teacher's manual) and the third one is the Teacher's toolkit. More information on the division and structure of the learning materials will follow during the training itself, Day 1.

- The guest teachers from Spain will have to read through all the 3 manuals on the topic **Energy** module 1, 2 and 3 (this one is also translated into Spanish, so it's possible to read it either in English or in Spanish, to be found under the O4 – IES el Palo folder).
- The guest teachers from the Netherlands will read through all the 3 manuals of the topics **Sustainability, climate change, carbon footprint** (to be found on Google Drive under O4 – Oudenaarde folder)
- The guest teachers from Italy will read through all the 3 manuals of the topics **Water and Waste** (to be found under O4 – ROCvA folder on Google Drive)
- The guest teachers from Belgium will read through all the 3 manuals of the topic **Raw materials and Management** (to be found under O4 – CIOFS folder on Google Drive)

Please mind that you have to read all the levels (sometimes these are separate documents, otherwise just one extended file).

1. Guest teachers prepare a 30 minute class based on the materials with the level or topic of their choice (it stand to reason that they choose a topic out of the piece they are reading though in preparation). We need 1 person per country to teach this short 30min class, so please decide yourself whether one person does it or both.
2. For Day 2 and 3 the guest teachers will have to prepare a creative content task, an interview or vlog where they share their impressions of the project and the learning materials. This task will be worked out into a magazine article or uploaded to the YouTube channel of the project (in case of a vlog). This is important to already during the preparation phase and later during the meeting itself or maybe even travels to make pictures / videos in order to produce

a nice piece at the end. Please let your creativity flow, no limitations about the format here, but think of making a max of a 2 min long video or not more than 2 A4 pages of text in case of an article / interview.
