Future skills for a better life in Sustainable Salons

The project Future skills for a better life in Sustainable Salons (Sustainable Salon) had its 4th offline meeting at the ROC Amsterdam in Amsterdam, The Netherlands. In this Erasmus+ project, we have gathered facts through an inventory of the hairdresser's future competences in the situation in a sustainable salon and focus on environmental aspects (core of a simple standard). In the meeting on 7th, 8th and 9th of November 2022, we discussed the experts' opinions on the final report on the future developments and competences. We also discussed the concept of the sustainable standard. A few adjustments will be made and the concept standard is already published on the website. The final versions of the self-assessment tools to map the current situation on the gap of the level towards the sustainability system on environment and sustainability in schools (salon) are also published on the website. The tool on competences of the entrepreneur is in concept published. Only the English and Spanish version are available at this moment. We discussed the first version of the learning material focused on the environment in a sustainable salon. End of January 2023 the next version will be ready. Also we worked on the awareness material on sustainability. Stickers are designed by students of the participating schools. Five designs are chosen to be produced. A magazine to create awareness will be developed in the coming period.

The project works with student participation along the project. In Amsterdam a 3 days programme was executed. Using the competences of the different partners, their network, the experts, entrepreneurs in the sector and the teachers and students in the conferences and at home in the schools we combine knowledge and perseverance to finalize the task in a good way.
