In this Erasmus+ project, we have gathered facts through an inventory of the hairdresser's future competences in the situation in a sustainable salon and focus on environmental aspects (core of a simple standard).

And we have made the first preparations on developing a self-assessment tool to map the current situation on the gap of the level towards the sustainability system on environment and sustainability in schools (salon) and on learning material focussed on the environment in a sustainable salon and awareness material on sustainability.
