Future skills for a better life in Sustainable Salons

The project Future Skills for a Better Life in Sustainable Salons (Sustainable Salon) had its final meeting in Verona and Pavia, Italy. In this Erasmus+ project we have gathered facts through an inventory of the future competences of the hairdresser. We developed a standard (ISO 14001) focusing on environmental aspects adapted to the hair and beauty salon. We have introduced self-assessment tools on the Internet, focusing on the environment in the salon and school and developed a tool on business skills. Learning materials are being developed for students in hair and beauty education at three levels: from beginner to entrepreneur.

In Verona we organised a multiplier event to disseminate the results of the project to the target groups: entrepreneurs, educators and organisations in the sector. We also presented the awareness-raising material we developed to support the dissemination: a magazine and stickers on sustainability that can be used in the salon and in schools. In Pavia we had the final partner meeting. We worked on the last tasks to be done to finish the project. The project will end on 31 August 2023.
